



Don Lloyd Servold
May 19, 1923 - May 26, 2005

Don Servold, 82, formerly of Canton, died at his home in Ft. Dodge, Iowa on May 26, surrounded by his children. A prayer service for Don was held on Monday evening, May 30. The funeral service remembering the life of Don was held at the Bethany Reformed Church in Canton, SD at 1:30 p.m. on May 31. Burial followed at Forest Hill Cemetery in Canton. Rec. Matthew Nix, pastor of the Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf (Sioux Falls), officiated the funeral services.

Don attended the South Dakota School for the Deaf in Sioux Falls. During WWII, he worked at an ammunition plant in Detroit, MI. After the war he returned home to South Dakota and worked at John Morrell & Co. for 41 years.

On November 1, 1946 Don was united in marriage to Lorraine Mayrose in Sioux Falls. Lorraine passed away on May 7, 1973. He was extremely proud of his family and his Norwegian heritage. Don was known to a friend to everybody. He knew no strangers. He was known to be a master carpenter and roofer.

Grateful for having shared his life are his children - Barb Jones, Nancy (Leroy) Feekes, David (Debbie) Servold, and Jeanne (Brian) Torberson, nine grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, three sisters and his twin sister.
