Elizabeth Mattox, age 108, of Sioux Falls, SD, passed away peacefully, on Saturday, May 3, 2014, at a local nursing home. Elizabeth had been known as one of the oldest living deaf individuals (and probably one of the oldest living individuals regardless of whether she was deaf or hearing) in the entire state of South Dakota. She led a quiet and simple life. She attended the Colorado School for the Deaf and then married Carl Mattox. Late in her life she moved to Sioux Falls, SD and lived with her sister, Faye Servold, until she passed away years ago. Elizabeth was a member of the South Dakota Association of the Deaf and the Deaf Seniors of South Dakota.
