Roger Berg died suddenly at his residence in Marshall, MN. He was born in Devils Lake, North Dakota and was an alumnus of the North Dakota School for the Deaf. He went on to attend the Southwest University (SSW) (Marshall) taking up sociology. At SSW he was also a member of the cross country teams.

Roger's enjoyments in life included playing sports as a youth before becoming an avid sports spectator, especially the Twins and Vikings. He competed in five marathons.

Roger married VeAnna Teschetter on Sept. 5, 1970. They lived in Pierre, SD and Edgerton, MN before moving to Marshall. The couple raised four children, including DeAnna Sweeney, a former CSD employee and currently working for CSDVRS, of Luverne and Jeff, also a former CSD employee of Clearwater, FL.
